
The registration process is in two parts. First, register for AMD Single Sign On (SSO), then register for ADAM.





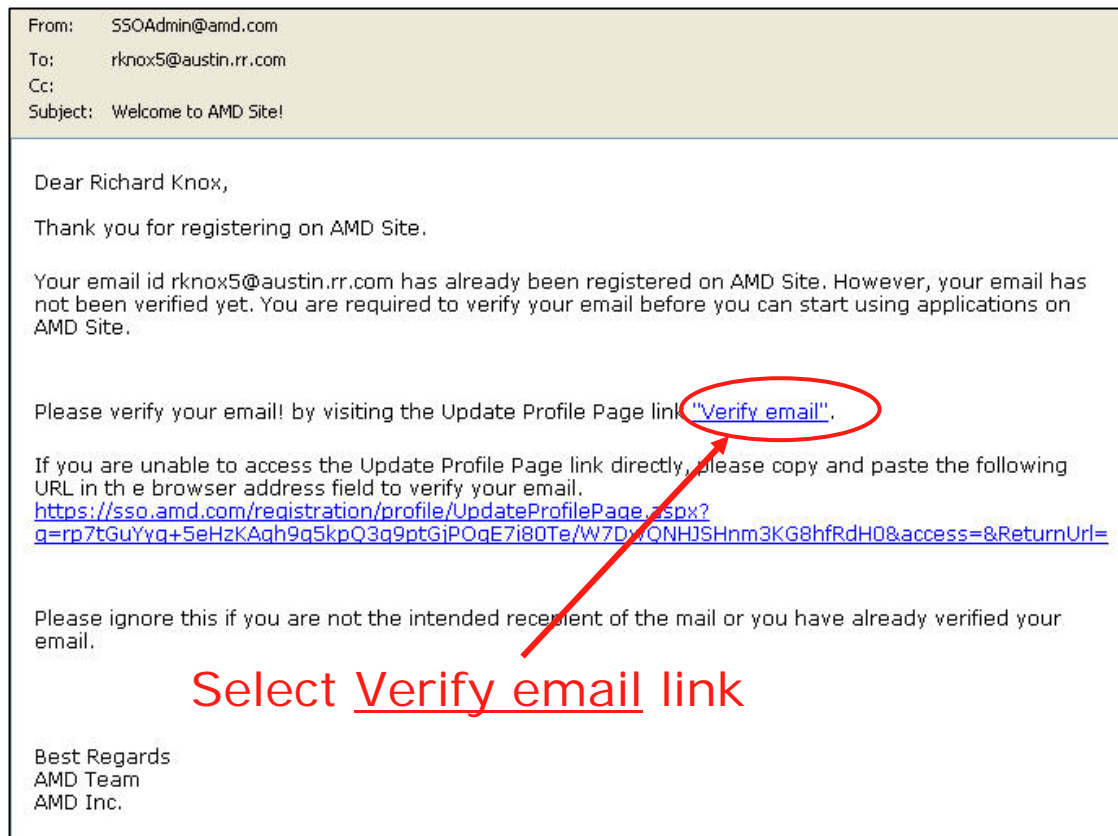
